Hello Cliff,

Yes. The Peninsula Airport Commission used our state entitlement funds to pay a portion of the Towne Bank \$4.5 million line of credit for People Express Airlines that you refer to below. \$3.5 million came from state entitlements, \$700 thousand came from RAISE and \$300 thousand came from the Small Community Air Service Development Grant (SCASD).
